L INTRODUCTION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made at Young Skilled India(YSIID Solutions Pvt. Ltd.), Varanasi,

The **HARISH CHANDRA PG COLLEGE, Varanasi (HCPGC)**, having its Registered Office , **Maidagin, Varanasi, UP, India**, through its Principal, **Prof. (Dr.) Rajnish Kunwar** (herein after called the **FIRST PARTY**), which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors, assignees and administrators hereinafter known as the **FIRST PARTY**.

AND

The **YSIID Solutions Pvt. Ltd. (YoungSkilledIndia)**, a **Govt. of India recognized Startup DIPP-1656**,incubated at **MCIE-IIT BHU**, having its registered office at **BP 20 (30) Patel Nagar, PDDUN, Chandauli - 232101, UP, India**, through its Chief Executive Officer, **Mr. Niraj Kumar Srivastava** (herein and after referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**),which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors, administrators, heirs, assigns and nominees of **SECOND PARTY**.

- 2. Professional & Life Skills Certificate Course - 3 months (Online/Offline Live & Interactive)**

WHEREAS

- A. Under National Educational Alliance for Technology (NEAT), the best technological solutions in education technology for enhancing the employability of the youth, adaptive and personalized learning, experiences for better learning outcomes, skill development in**

niche areas related solutions/ products, evaluated by AICTE and offered by Edtech company SECOND PARTY has been brought under a common platform with a scheme to offer these solutions as per the common pricing policy for student & learner community.

- B. AICTE is the Implementation Agency for the NEAT scheme for better learning outcomes in education through Public-Private Partnerships, which identify the SECOND PARTY, whose products "Management Certificate Course" with all the possible specialization like HR, Marketing, Finance, Operations, IT, Yoga Life Coaching (HRM), project Management, Tourism & Hospitality, Educational Management & Administration, AI & ML Management, etc. have been brought under the NEAT scheme for the benefit of students of our country .
- C. Since as per MoU with the AICTE , Young Skilled India, as Ed-Tech Company has offered some FREE seats which would be distributed to the appropriate beneficiaries (economically and socially weaker students and especially in remote areas) by AICTE as per policy of the Ministry of Education. So this will be applicable to the registered students through FIRST PARTY as well.
- D. The MoU has been signed between AICTE and the Young Skilled India, Product/s / Course/s / Solution/s for implementing the NEAT scheme effectively. The number of Product(s) / Course(s) / Solution(s) will be part of MoU (as an annexure). The amendment will be automatically deemed to be included as a part of a MoU with FIRST PARTY.
- E. Once the students are registered, FIRST PARTY cannot off-board the students and exit the MoU till completion of course and certification. In case the FIRST PARTY wants to exit the MoU all liabilities related to the students are to be fulfilled by the FIRST PARTY.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS MoU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1.0 Roles and Responsibilities of the FIRST PARTY

- 1.1 The product "Management Certificate Course" included in the Annexure, should be offered, promote, enroll, EXCLUSIVELY through NEAT, AICTE portal only, by the FIRST PARTY on behalf of Young Skilled India. To develop the employability of the Students & Working Professionals, FIRST PARTY will be free to extend this course to its alumni, any individual or working professionals, along with the College / University affiliated Students.
- 1.2 The student would initially register as a learner/student through the NEAT AICTE portal, although student will make payment and subsequently access the product through SECOND PARTY LMS through NEAT AICTE portal only.

- 1.3 FIRST PARTY will maintain Exclusivity of the "**Management Certificate Course**", which will be monitored and checked on a regular basis by Young Skilled India team for honouring this MoU.
- 1.4 The FIRST PARTY will be facilitating its students for **self financed Integration** of regular **Degree Courses** with **Management Certificate Course** (evaluated by AICTE) for **dual certification** to all UG , PG, Ph.D & Diploma Students.
- 1.5 Conducting workshops, Webinars through SECOND PARTY, **offering class space for conducting the online live classes, conducting offline classes.** Campus visit arrangement for the Young Skilled India Officials for conducting the workshops, Webinars etc.
- 1.6 FIRST PARTY will be **authorised** to enroll the students & working professionals for **Management Certificate Course** in all the possible specialization like HR, Marketing, Finance, IT, Operations etc., as a **YOUNG SKILLED INDIA CENTER FOR "MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATE COURSE"** under the **NEAT, AICTE, Ministry of Education** scheme. FIRST PARTY will ensure a representation of the center by providing an office space & **10*20 feet banner, sign board** to counsel and inform the students ,visiting working professionalas & women etc.
- 1.7 Establishing and maintaining the two tier grievances redressal mechanism for resolving the students grievances as follows:
 - (a) Normally all grievances should be resolved within 24 hours or by next working day.
 - (b) Any grievance that is not resolved within 48 hours should be automatically escalated to the next level in the Young Skilled India ear marked for grievance redressal.
 - (c) An email address will be provided by the FIRST PARTY for grievance redressal.
- 1.8 FIRST PARTY can ONLY mention that "Product evaluated by AICTE" for only those products offered through NEAT AICTE Portal which are part of Annexure of this MoU.
- 1.9 FIRST PARTY will be authorised to Promote the "**Management Certificate Course**" with specillization in **HR, Marketing, Finance, Operations, IT, Tourism & Hospitality, Yoga Life Coaching (HRM), Project Management, Educational Management & Administration, AI & ML Management** etc. **along with Professional & Life Skills Certificate Course** based on time to time new additions and approvals of the authorised stream of certificate courses only , SECOND PARTY will be authorised as a strategic partner of FIRST PARTY to ensure smooth implementation of the program. **FIRST PARTY will be authorised to use the logo of Young Skilled India** in any of the promotion, based on prior information and approvals , viceversa will be true for Young Skilled India. FIRST PARTY is authorising Young Skilled India to promote the

College/University & its faculty involved for the authorised courses in all the promotions, webinars, workshops etc.

2.0 Roles and Responsibilities of SECOND PARTY

2.1 Young Skilled India will provide support to FIRST PARTY for promoting the course among the Departments, Faculties & Students by organising regular workshops / webinar / to encourage the students/learners.

2.2 The SECOND PARTY will be responsible for conducting online/offline live classes, formation of batches as per specialization, attendance, assignments, tests, exams, issuing the certificates etc. to the successful students, in coordination with the FIRST PARTY. The progress of the students, along with the placement, internships and related information will get shared with the FIRST PARTY, IQAC on timely basis.

3.0 Commencement, Duration, Amendment and Termination of MoU

3.1 The MoU shall remain in effect from the date of execution until terminated by the either party.

3.2 This MoU may be amended upon the mutual consent of both the parties and should be in writing.

3.3 SECOND PARTY would be free to terminate the MoU in case SECOND PARTY is not satisfied with the performance, quality, deliverables and unethical practice or disobeying any terms and conditions laid down by SECOND PARTY, from time to time. However, SECOND PARTY before terminating the MoU would give 30 days' notice in writing to the FIRST PARTY.

3.4 In case the FIRST PARTY wants to terminate the MoU, they may do so by giving a 30 days' advance notice in writing and showing 'zero' enrollments. The existing learners/students enrolled shall receive all scheduled deliverables as per the Initial purchase agreement.

4.0 Dispute Redressal

4.1 Each organization shall announce a coordinator for the execution of MoU. In case of any dispute between the Parties, the dispute shall be amicably resolved in a meeting of the coordinators of organizations. However, if such an effort fails it shall be referred to the VC/ Principal / Registrar/CEO/MD/Director (Decision Maker) of the Company. If dispute is not resolved amicably, then it will be resolved through arbitration.

4.2 The arbitration proceedings shall be as per the provisions contained in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended from time to time and in force when the reference is made). The venue of the arbitration proceedings shall be at Varanasi and the proceedings shall be in English language. If any dispute still remains unresolved, the same shall be adjudicated by the Court of law at Varanasi.

5.0 Force Majeure

5.1 If at any time, during the continuance of this MoU, the performance in whole or in part, by either party, of any obligation under this is prevented or delayed, by reason of war, or hostility, acts of the public enemy, civic commotion, sabotage, Act of State or direction from Statutory Authority, explosion, epidemic, quarantine restriction, strikes and lockouts (as are not limited to the establishments and facilities of the Company), fire, floods, natural calamities or any act of GOD (hereinafter referred to as EVENT), provided notice of happenings of any such EVENT is given by the affected party to the other, within 21 Calendar days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall, by reason of such event, be entitled to terminate the MoU, nor shall either party have any such claims for damages against the other, in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance. Provided SERVICE under the Company shall be resumed as soon as practicable, after such EVENT comes to an end or ceases to exist.

Kunwar hereinafter referred to as 'HCPGC' (which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, lawful representatives and permitted assigns) of the Second Party (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party"). WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

UPC and HCPGC have many areas of common interest in academic, education and research such as Sciences, Social Science, and Humanities considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research, and administrative.

NOW THEREFORE, UPC and HCPGC have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (here-in-after referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

1. Objectives

The goal is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for better experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. Udai Pratap College and Harish Chandra Post Graduate College are agree:

- 1.1 to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
- 1.2 to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- 1.3 to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- 1.4 to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.

2. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

UPC and HCPGC agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between UPC and HCPGC.

3. Exchange of Faculty and Staff

UPC and HCPGC agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and staff from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms. Notwithstanding the above, UPC and HCPGC will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund international travel by their faculty/students.

4. Student Exchange

UPC and HCPGC agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is



expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- 4.1 Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- 4.2 An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- 4.3 An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- 4.4 His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- 4.5 The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- 4.6 The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.
- 4.7 If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- 4.8 If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.
- 4.9 To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home institution.
- 4.10 The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.


5. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material

UPC and HCPGC will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, UPC and HCPGC agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

6. Joint Conferences, workshops and short-term courses

UPC and HCPGC agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between UPC and HCPGC.

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7. Intellectual Property

UPC and HCPGC agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

8. Tenure and Termination


This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither UPC nor HCPGC will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, both the institutions will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

Udai Pratap College, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh and Harish Chandra Post Graduate College, Varanasi Uttar Pradesh welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.


