Post-active stages

Pre- Active Stage (पूर्व क्रिया अवस्था)

- It is the phase of **PLANNING** for teaching. (योजना चरण)
- इस अवस्था में अध्यापक शिक्षण नियोजन (**Teaching Planning**) करता है।
 - Establishment of some kind of goals or objectives.
 - (1) गोल्स / उद्देश्यों का निर्धारण
 - Discovering ways and means to achieve these objectives.
 - (2) सिखाई जाने वाली सामग्री, पद्धति, रणनीतियों का चयन

Establishment of some kind of goals or objectives

- Fixing of the goals
 - Change in behavior
 - Content to be taught
 - Objectives taxonomy
 - Need and relevance of the topic
 - Level of motivation
 - Level of the learner
 - Duration

Discovering ways and means to active these objectives

- Content selection, collection , orderly arrangement
- Methods selection
- Strategies
- Devices
- About the evaluation device
- Distribution of method strategies and devices (lesson Plan)

Interactive stages(अन्तः प्रक्रिया अवस्था)

- This is stage of conduction and implementation
- **Jackson says** :“The teacher provides pupil verbal stimulation of various kinds, makes explanations, ask questions, listen to the student’s response and provide guidance”.
- includes all those activities which a teacher uses after entering the classroom.
- includes actual teaching done in the classroom.
